## MASS TRANSIT

Metrobus operates nearly 100 bus routes, including the Miami Beach Airport Express (Route 150), which goes from Miami International Airport (MIA) to South Beach. Metrorail is the city's elevated train system. The Metrorail Orange Line whisks riders from MIA to Downtown in no time. Getting around Downtown Miami is easy, thanks to the automated Metromover. Trolleys are a fun way to get around in Coconut Grove, Coral Gables, Doral, Downtown Miami, Miami Beach and Wynwood. There's even a free trolley that takes visitors from Historic Downtown Homestead to Everglades National Park and Biscayne National Park during the winter and spring high season. The Brightline offers rail service to and from points north from Downtown Miami's brand new MiamiCentral Station. The Lyft ridesharing application connects people with affordable and reliable rides within minutes.

## CRUISE CAPITAL

Miami is called the Cruise Capital of the World™ for good reason. Several major cruise lines and an impressive array of new ships call PortMiami home. Many visitors spend a few extra days pre- or post-cruise to explore all that Greater Miami and Beaches has to offer.

Miami International Airport's automated passport control (APC) kiosks are now available to travelers from the 38 countries participating in the U.S. Department of State's Visa Waiver Program (WVP). APC technology allows travelers arriving at MIA from abroad to have their passports processed in less than two minutes via a self-service APC kiosk instead of waiting in line for a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officer. MIA is one of only a few U.S. airports with expedited processing for pre-approved travelers. There are two ways to speed things up: Global Entry and TSA Pre-Check. ## USEFUL TIPS & INFORMATION

### AREA & POPULATION

Greater Miami and the Beaches is spread over 2,000 square miles (5,180 square kilometers) at the southeastern tip of the Florida peninsula. The Intracoastal Waterway separates the Miami mainland and Miami Beach, located on the Atlantic Ocean. More than two million people reside here, bringing to the area a rich cultural diversity.

### GRATUITIES

Customarily, gratuities of 15 to 18 percent are paid to hospitality industry personnel who render personal services. You may find a restaurant has already added the gratuity to the bill. If you are given assistance with your baggage, \$1 per bag is appropriate. Taxi drivers are usually tipped 15 percent of the fare. When a doorman or valet calls for a taxi, a \$1 tip is generally appropriate. This is also true for the attendant who retrieves your car from valet parking. When tipping for maid service, \$1 per day is a good guideline. Should you engage a concierge's services, tip according to the type of service provided.

### DRIVING & TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

U.S. law stipulates driving on the right-hand side of the road and passing on the left. Right turns are permitted at red lights unless otherwise indicated. Always note posted speed limits. All persons riding in an automobile are required to wear seat belts. Children under five years of age must be fastened securely in government-approved child car seats. Division of Driver Licenses: 305/229-6333. The State of Florida recognizes valid U.S. driver licenses, international driver licenses and valid licenses issued in other countries. Tow-away Zones: Tow-away zones are indicated by signs posted at the curb.

### LIQUOR LAWS & SMOKING

The legal drinking age is 21. Smoking is prohibited inside restaurants in Miami-Dade County.

## THE CONCIERGE

In this high-tech age — one in which it often seems impossible to reach a human being when phoning a business — the concierge's devotion to personal service is something of an anachronism, albeit a welcome one.
